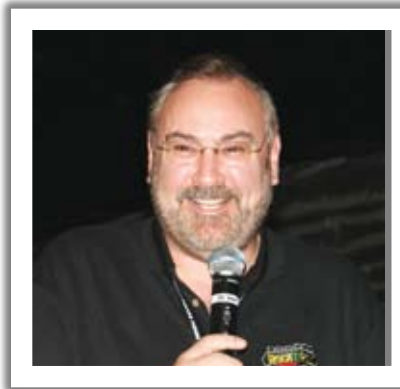

*David Fishof*

*Producer, Founder,  
Rock ‘n’ Roll Fantasy Camp*

Whether he’s producing a tour, assembling an All-Starr band, or writing a best-selling book, there’s one thing David Fishof is always doing, and that’s dreaming. Hailed as one of the most creative and innovative entertainment producers in the world, David has been responsible for some of the most original, successful and exciting live shows ever brought to the stage.

After years of good fortune working with the likes of veteran rockers like Roger Daltrey, Ringo Starr, The Monkees, Levon Helm, Joe Walsh, Todd Rundgren, Jack Bruce, and Dr. John, David decided it was time to share his experiences with rock fans around the world. With the help of some of the musical legends he had worked with over the years, David created Rock ‘n’ Roll Fantasy Camp, a place where rock dreams come true.

In November 2007, Rock ‘n’ Roll Fantasy Camp celebrated its 10th anniversary with a star-studded Camp that featured Roger Daltrey, Joe Walsh, Slash, Vince Neil and Jack Bruce as guest counselors.

In addition to founding Rock ‘n’ Roll Fantasy Camp, David’s impressive career highlights include reuniting The Monkees for their blowout reunion tour in 1986 and producing Dirty Dancing: The Concert Tour, Dick Clark’s American Bandstand Tour, The Happy Together Tours, Classic Superfest, American Gladiators Live Tour, Mortal Kombat Live Tour, and the British Rock Symphony (which featured Peter Frampton, Roger Daltrey, Alice Cooper, and Jon Anderson). David also created Ringo Starr and His All Starr Band concept with Ringo Starr and, over the years, David has produced 8 All Star Band tours.

David’s career has also spanned the sports world as well. He has represented legends such as NFL greats Phil Simms, Mark Bavaro, Vince Ferragamo, and Jack Reynolds as well as baseball stars Lou Piniella, Dave Magadan and Randy Myers. David also authored the best-selling book *Putting It On The Line* about sports and entertainment.

David is currently writing his second book and lectures across the country. He was last year’s featured speaker at the National Speakers Association in August 2008. David resides in Los Angeles and is the proud father of five, grandfather of three, and husband of Karen Finkel.



### *Teddy Andreadis*

Teddy Andreadis (aka Teddy Zig Zag) has gained a reputation as a rock-solid keyboardist, a wailing harmonica player, a soulful singer, B3 player and an insightful musical arranger.

Teddy has toured and shared the stage with some of the biggest names in music, including: Carole King, Guns 'n' Roses, Roger Daltrey, Jeff Skunk Baxter, Alice Cooper, Slash, Nikki Sixx, Bo Diddley,

Chuck Berry, BB King and Michael Jackson. His discography reads like a Who's Who in Music. His video work alone includes: Michael Jackson's "Give In To Me", Guns 'n' Roses' "November Rain", "Yesterdays", "Garden of Eden" and "Es-tranged", and Carole King's "In Concert". He also appears on the Guns 'n' Roses "Use Your Illusion" Live 2-DVD set, and most recently played on Velvet Re-volver's latest CD. Teddy's own CD, "Innocent Loser", was received with wide acclaim through Samsung records. His second CD will be released in Spring 2009.



### *Elliot Easton*

Elliot Easton is best known for being the left-handed guitarist from The Cars, the most successful American new wave band to emerge in the late 1970's. As lead guitarist for The Cars, Easton has sold over 30 million records worldwide and has cemented a reputation for memorable solos, great tones and an uncanny ear for catchy melodies. Elliot Easton has spent his career recording and performing for fans around the world. Elliot recently reunited

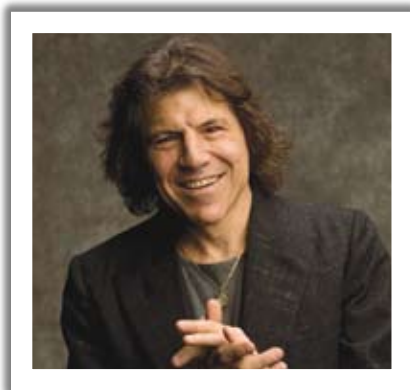
with original Cars keyboardist Greg Hawkes and has been touring again with The New Cars whose lineup includes Todd Rundgren on vocals, Prairie Prince on drums and Kasim Sulton on bass.



### *Mark Farner*

A true rock 'n roll legend, Mark Farner found fame and success at 20 years of age as the leader of one of America's biggest bands of the 1970's - the original Grand Funk Railroad. The band recorded 17 albums with total sales of more than 25 million records. Mark Farner is the unmistakable voice, guitarist, and songwriter that powered the original Grand Funk Railroad to 12 platinum and 15 gold albums.

In 1969, Mark started the original Grand Funk Railroad with teenage friends Mel Schacher and Don Brewer - one of the first American power trios was born. The saga of Grand Funk Railroad is well documented. The hit singles included "I'm Your Captain (Closer To Home)", "Foot-Stompin' Music", "We're an American Band", "the Loco-motion", "Mean Mistreater", "Bad Time", "Some Kind Of Wonderful" and others. In early 1977, Grand Funk Railroad called it quits, and after taking a year or so off, Mark Farner signed a solo deal with Atlantic Records and issued two critically acclaimed albums: "Mark Farner" and "No Frills". In 1981, a reunited Grand Funk Railroad recorded 2 new albums, "Grand Funk Lives" for Full Moon/Warner Bros. Records, and "What's Funk". Mark released 4 contemporary Christian albums from 1983 through 1994, earning a Dove nomination. His continuous touring schedule keeps him in contact with both his longtime Grand Funk fans, and the new fans that first noticed Mark during his solo years.



### *Sandy Gennaro*

Sandy Gennaro was born and raised in NYC and currently resides in Staten Island NY. Sandy has toured and/or recorded with the following artists: Bo Diddley, Cyndi Lauper, Joan Jett and the Blackhearts, The Pat Travers Band, Johnny Winter, Joe Lynn Turner, The Monkees, Michael Bolton, Benny Mardones, Craaft, and Jon Paris. Sandy has also made numerous TV appearances including The Tonight Show, The Grammy Awards, The

American Music Awards, The MTV New Years Ball, and David Letterman among others. Sandy has been giving private lesson and teaching master classes at The Drummers Collective in NYC since 1987 and proudly endorses DW drums, pedals and hardware, Paiste cymbals, Hot Sticks, Remo heads and Rhythm Tech percussion. ## Mark Hudson

Grammy award winning songwriter  
Mark Hudson has had an amazingly varied career spanning everything including musician, producer and songwriter.

He has written with and for multi-platinum artists such as Aerosmith, Burt Bacharach, Carole King, Ringo Starr, Ozzy Osbourne, Celine Dion, Bon Jovi and many more.

His production credits include Ringo Starr, Aerosmith, Ozzy Osbourne Hanson and many other artists. Mark is currently

writing with Steven Tyler for a new Aerosmith album.



## Rami Jaffee

You probably know Rami Jaffee from founding the Wallflowers 20 years ago or playing with the Foo Fighters today. His extensive recording career includes everyone from Johnny Cash to Macy Gray and hundreds of others, most of them selling millions of records. Holding one Grammy and having played on a dozen Grammy winning records, Rami continues his career with composing and producing as well as his session and live work.



## Bruce Kulick

Bruce Kulick has been playing professionally since 1975. He first gained notoriety as a member of the touring band for Meat Loaf's classic "Bat Out Of Hell" album in 1977. Shortly after, Bruce formed the band Blackjack with a then aspiring singer named Michael Bolton. After the release of two albums, Blackjack folded and Bruce was asked to join KISS, where he remained as their lead guitarist for twelve years.

After leaving KISS, Bruce formed Union with John Corabi in 1997, who would go on to release three albums between 1998 and 2000. Bruce and John teamed up with Eric Singer and formed the Eric Singer Project (E.S.P.), releasing an album in 1998. In early 2001, Bruce released his debut solo album Audio Dog, which was followed in 2003 with Transformer. In 2001 Bruce joined Grand Funk Railroad as lead guitarist after receiving a personal invitation from drummer Don Brewer. Bruce is still touring with GFR and currently in his 9th year as their lead guitarist.

Currently, Bruce is involved with the Monster Circus, a high energy Vegas show at the Hilton and is promoting a forthcoming third solo CD titled BK3. The full CD will feature Gene Simmons, Nick Simmons, Steve Lukather, John Corabi and Doug Fieger from the Knack and will be out in 2009. ## Steve Lukather

Versatile musician, guitarist, vocalist, composer, producer and arranger, Steve Lukather was born in Los Angeles on October 21 in 1957. In 1976, Steve joined the band Toto, and in 1977, Toto released their first album "Toto" that generated the hit singles "Hold the line", "I'll supply the love" and "Georgy Porgy". With that album, Steve Lukather started a more than 25 year Toto career. Lukather contributed to Michael Jackson's "Thriller" album,

which became a huge commercial success, and the album "Toto IV" went platinum with the hits singles "Rosanna" and "Africa" becoming all time classics. In 1989, Steve released his first solo album, and has released four more since. Steve has also won five Grammy Awards for his work with Toto and the album: "Larry Carlton & Steve Lukather - No substitutions, live in Osaka".



## *Duff McKagan*

In 1984, having outgrown Seattle's insular punk rock scene, Duff McKagan moved to Los Angeles in search of rock 'n roll adventure. It turned out to be a pretty good move. As a founding member of Guns 'n Roses, he sold over 40 million albums and played to over 20 million music fans before leaving the band in 1995. During that time, the band was awarded 2 American Music Awards and 3 MTV Music awards, changing the face and scope of

rock music forever. Returning to Seattle in 1996 to build a family and attend the Albers School of Business at Seattle University, he, always loving a challenge, made the dean's list and president's list as a 4.0 student. Duff continued to hone his writing skills and inevitably found himself reuniting with a couple Guns band mates, evolving into his 2nd major musical success, Velvet Revolver. VR's debut album was a Billboard #1 album and earned Duff a Grammy, nearly 20 years after his initial move to LA. Duff is currently launching the campaign of his newest project, Duff McKagan's Loaded, to fan and critic acclaim. The Wasted Heart EP was released in the fall of 2008, selling out a limited run quickly, with the band's most recent release, Sick, on March 24th.



## *Slim Jim Phantom*

As the legendary drummer for the Stray Cats, Slim Jim Phantom, alongside band mates Brian Setzer and Lee Rocker, spear-headed the neo-rockabilly movement of the early '80s. With a love for '50s rock n' roll, the Stray Cats took inspiration from the bygone era and mixed it with their youthful energy and aggression, producing the updated hard-edged rockabilly sound that saw them conquer London,

Europe and later the US. Between tours,

Jim can often be found jamming with friends at the world famous "Cat Club" on Hollywood's Sunset Strip, a nightclub that he owns and runs. Summer 2008 saw Jim and the Stray Cats return for an extensive tour of Europe. Jim also divides his time between his own explosive self-named roots-rock trio and "The Head Cat", starring Motorhead's Lemmy Kilmister and Danny B Harvey. The latter is set to release a new record in 2009 and tours are likely for both bands. In addition, 2009 will see the launch of Slim Jim's newest musical project "The Forgotten Saints", a band co-founded with old friends, and former "Dead Men Walking" bandmates, Captain Sensible (The Damned) and Mike Peters (The Alarm).



## *Share Ross*

Share Ross formerly Share Pedersen, was the bassist for platinum femme rockers Vixen and "All Star" group Contraband with Michael Schenker, Tracii Guns and Bobby Blotzer. Widely known for her prowess as a player in both bands she's gone on to blaze a trail as a guitar player, songwriter and singer with her indie rock band, Bubble which won Song of the Year in the John Lennon Songwriting Contest and toured throughout the US, UK

and Japan. Share won Best Female Guitarist twice in LA, produces bands out of her recording studio and currently hosts an online video show, "Rock n Roll TV".



## *Todd Rundgren*

Born and raised in Philadelphia, Rundgren began playing guitar as a teenager, going on to found and front The Nazz, the quint-essential 60's cult group. In 1969, he left the band to pursue a solo career, recording his debut offering, the legendary "Runt." But it was 1972's seminal "Something/Anything?" (on which he played all the instruments, sang all the vocal parts, and acted as his own producer) that catapulted Todd into the superstar limelight. It was

followed by such landmark LPs as "The Hermit of Mink Hollow" and "A Wizard, A True Star," as well as such hit singles as "I Saw The Light", "Hello It's Me", "Can We Still Be Friends", and "Bang The Drum". In 1974, Todd formed Utopia, an entirely new approach to the concept of interactive musicianship, and embarked on an extensive round of touring and recording.

Rundgren's myriad production projects include albums by Patti Smith, Cheap Trick, Psychedelic Furs, Meatloaf, XTC, Grand Funk Railroad, and Hall and Oates. Rounding out his reputation as rock's Renaissance Man, Rundgren composed all the music and lyrics for Joe Papp's 1989 Off-Broadway production of Joe Orton's "Up Against It". He also has composed the music for a number of television series, including "Pee Wee's Playhouse" and "Crime Story".



## *Rudy Sarzo*

Rudy Sarzo has been a professional recording and performing artist worldwide for over 25 years. As a member of Ozzy Osbourne's band, he toured the world in support of the "Blizzard of Ozz" and "Diary of a Madman" records. As a member of Quiet Riot, Rudy recorded the multi-platinum album "Metal Health." During this period he headlined worldwide tours, appeared on numerous MTV videos and was voted #1 Bassist by Circus Maga-

zine in 1983. Rudy was also a member of Whitesnake, in the late '80's and early '90's. Rudy was then reunited with Quiet Riot from 1997 until 2003. His recordings with all of these artists combined have sold over 30 million copies.

In 2004, Rudy joined Yngwie Malmsteen's Rising Force for the U.S. 30 city "Attack Tour". Since April of 2004, Rudy has been a proud member of the multi-platinum Heavy Metal group DIO. When not touring with DIO he also tours with Blue Oyster Cult and performs with Monster Circus at the Las Vegas Hilton.



## *Danny Seraphine*

Danny Seraphine is one of the world's most highly-respected rock drummers. He was the drummer, percussionist and a founding member of the multi-million selling, Grammy award winning band Chicago. From 1967 to 1990, Seraphine played on and helped produce 19 gold and 13 platinum albums, and 50 Top 40 hits. Today Danny plays with his band, California Transit Authority or CTA.



## *Steven Tyler*

Musician, singer, songwriter. Born Stephen Victor Tallarico, in Yonkers, New York. As the lead singer of Aerosmith, Steven Tyler is considered one of rock's greatest showmen. The son of a music teacher, he started playing drums, but then focused on singing. After moving to Boston in the late 1960s, Tyler eventually met up the musicians that would form the rock group Aerosmith.

Aerosmith is the best-selling American hard rock band of all time, having sold 150 million albums worldwide, including 66.5 million albums in the United States alone. They also hold the record for the most gold and multi-platinum albums by an American group. The band has scored 21 Top 40 hits on the Billboard Hot 100, nine #1 Mainstream Rock hits, four Grammy Awards, and ten MTV Video Music Awards. They were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2001, and in 2005 they were ranked #57 in Rolling Stone magazine's 100 Greatest Artists of All Time.



### *Alan White*

After a short stint with Ginger Baker's Airforce in 1968, featuring Ginger Baker and Steve Winwood, Alan was invited to play with John Lennon in the Plastic Ono Band and recorded the legendary hit "Imagine" along with "Instant Karma" and many others. He then recorded with George Harrison on the album "All Things Must Pass" and the hit song "My Sweet Lord". In 1972, while touring with Joe Cocker, he was asked to join the progres-

sive rock band YES. Alan and YES gave each other 3 months to see if their styles were compatible and 27 years later Alan is still writing and playing with YES.



### *Kip Winger*

Kip Winger has been playing music since he was 5 years old. He has performed, written and produced with numerous bands and musicians including Alice Cooper and Alan Parsons, but is best known for being the singer and bassist in Winger, the highly successful band on his own name-sake. Kip still tours with Winger as well as touring as a solo acoustic artist, scoring classical music, film soundtracks, producing and songwriting with other artists.

## *Special Guests*

**BILLY AMENDOLA** - Billy Amendola's band Mantus charted three Top 10 dance singles and toured the U.S., Canada, and Europe in the mid-to-late 70's. Throughout the eighties and nineties, as a session drummer, Billy played on numerous recording projects and jingles, including Debbie Gibson's smash hit "Only In My Dreams" which earned him a triple-platinum record award. He is currently concentrating on songwriting and producing and is an Associate Editor at Modern Drummer Publications.

**CARMEN APPICE** - Carmine first came into the spotlight with the band Vanilla Fudge in the late 60's. In 1970, with the end of Vanilla Fudge, Carmine went on to form Cactus with bassist Tim Bogert, and then joined Rod Stewart's band in 1976. Today, this bad boy of the Food Network hosts four popular shows and can barely walk down the street without being recognized. Between his newest show, "Guy off the Hook", where he gets up-close and personal with a live studio audience, to "Guy's Big Bite", where he teaches viewers how to make creative dishes with bold flavors and "Ultimate Recipe Showdown", where he showcases home cooks' best recipes, to traveling across America to find the most unique "Diners, Drive-Ins and Dives", Guy brings his unique personality to Food Network several times a week.
